TACTICS INSTRUCTION

BASIC TACTICS

Weapon Choice: Choose the Spitfire if you like stealth and just using one hand to shoot. The Spitfire is smaller and quieter. Choose the Commando if you like to shoot from far. The Commando is bigger, louder, shoots twice as far.

Shooting: Line up your shots quickly, keep weapon & scope ready. When taking hits, hide immediately. Once you take a hit you cannot win a duel.

Don't Cluster: Clustering can get all of you shot by one opponent or friendly fire.

Proper Use Of Bunkers: Avoid touching the bunkers, it gives away your position. Don't stand so that you are visible above the bunker, you'll get shot from all angles. Slowly pop out the side scanning the view for opponents.

Leave The Base: The easiest way to lose a battle is to get most of your force trapped at the base. Once you respawn, try to get a good nearby position quickly.

Communication: Effective squads communicate. Let them know when you are pinned down and from where. Communicate opponent locations & movements.

ADVANCED TACTICS

Movement: Whenever possible, move quickly and silently, constantly scanning the view with your weapon ready.

Stay On Your Feet: Avoid lying down or limiting your mobility. You always want the ability to change your position or angle quickly, even pounce when appropriate.

Wait For A Good Shot: Shooting blindly or through cover rarely makes a hit, but it's great for getting you noticed. Don't give up your position until you have a shot.

Suppress & Flank: This tactic is the most effective military maneuver. Have one player or group of players shoot to keep opponents pinned while another player or group of players moves around the side to get a better angle. Once you have two wide angles on the opponent the game gets much easier.

Send Out A Scout: In advanced missions, don't risk giving away your entire task force's position. Send out a scout to look for opponents. If he/she gets shot you can determine where opponents are without being seen yourself.
